There will be no in-person registry counter service in Sydney CBD, Liverpool, Penrith, Parramatta and Wollongong on those days. Please make contact by phone or email.

# Mask and face coverings

In response to the latest COVID-19 health advice, face masks are now compulsory in all NCAT premises.

### Attending in person

Please do not attend an NCAT Registry or an in-person Tribunal hearing:

- If you have had close contact with someone diagnosed with or suspected or confirmed as having Coronavirus (COVID-19) in the last 14 days
- If you are feeling unwell and experiencing any of the following symptoms fever, cough, sore throat or shortness of breath

Registrars/Sheriff officers may deny entry or request any person to leave a building.

NSW Health advise that people should stay at home if they are feeling unwell.
